Science Project Exhibition - Innovative models and experiments presented by students.

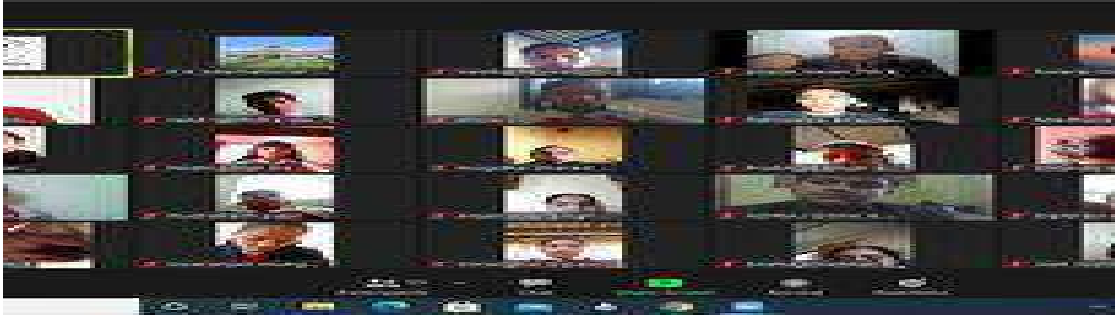




Parent teacher meeting
